MMH committed funds to create a premier Heart and Vascular Center that will offer world-class clinical care in a patient and family-friendly environment, in response to a regional and national growing need to address heart disease. The new cardiovascular center will replace the 1940s-era hospital and consolidate clinical departments, including a cardiac diagnostic suite, multiple cardiac clinics, patient outreach laboratory, radiology, and vascular clinic.
