

“Detroit’s Yacht Club, America’s Largest”

Description: Founded in 1868, the Detroit Yacht Club occupies its fifth and grandest club house built in 1922. This Mediterranean styled building is a nationally registered historic place. Designed by George Mason, it is 93,000 square feet large, making it the largest in the United States and to club’s knowledge, the Western Hemisphere. The club-house, occupied by the name-sake club and the 501c3 non-profit, Detroit Yacht Club Foundation both work to address maintenance challenges and collaboratively reserve the historically significant exterior. The Club house has many unique design features which makes it a must-see visit of grand, historic structures.
