• Open to students who graduated anytime since May of 2012, but you must not submit a professional project, it must be a project completed while in school.

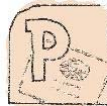


