RIP: Edgar Parks, Friend of AIA Michigan

Edgar Eugene Parks passed away on November 21st. Ed, as he was known to his friends, was a civil engineer and spent forty-one [41] years in the employ of Albert Kahn Associates [AKA], Architects and Engineers, in Detroit, Michigan, completing his last

eight [8] years as its Chairman of the Board, President and CEO, retiring from AKA in 1992.

Ed was recognized many times and in many ways for his leadership in his Profession and his dedication to the building industry earned him numerous awards from ESD, MSPE, and other organizations including, being an ESD Fellow and a ESD Gold Awardee.
