TROY ARCHITECT WINS HASTINGS AWARD FROM AIA MICHIGAN

May 30, 2014- Detroit, Michigan- The American Institute of Architects Michigan has selected architect Kirk H. Delzer, AIA, NCARB for its prestigious Hastings Award. He will be honored at the annual Celebration of Architecture on June 7 at the Eli and Edythe Broad Art Museum in East Lansing

The Hastings Award was established in 1978 to recognize a specific outstanding contribution to the architectural profession. Robert Hastings, FAIA, was a Detroit architect who rose through the local, state, and national components of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) and became National President in 1970. AIA Michigan created the Award in 1978 in his honor.

Kirk H. Delzer, AIA, NCARB, is a Senior Vice President at Integrated Design Solutions. As the firm's K12 Market Principal Leader, Kirk has been involved with several hundred design projects in Michigan school districts including most recently: Southfield Public Schools, Oakland Schools, Holly Area Schools, Fenton Area Public Schools, Troy School District and Linden Community Schools. He takes great pride in assisting districts with planning and implementing quality learning environments for students, staff and communities. He has recently been involved with University of Michigan's newest housing project, the Munger Graduate Residence Building, a \$185M program currently under construction. Kirk is an active participant in AIA Michigan functions, and is very involved in mentoring young architects in his firm. He holds active memberships in AIAMI, NCARB, MSBO, MASB, and CEFPI.

Kirk holds Bachelor of Science and Master of Architecture degrees from the University of Michigan and became a registered architect in 1979. He and his wife, Marilyn, moved to Troy in 1986 and in 1999, he became a founding member of Integrated Design Solutions in Troy, Michigan.
